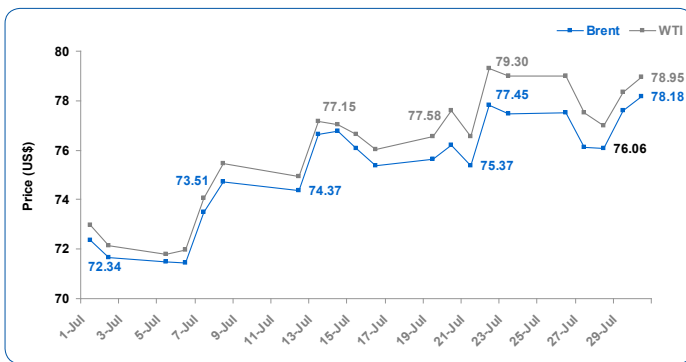
DGCX July trading volumes increase 37% to 156,242 contracts

- 156,242 contracts traded in July, valued at US \$828 million, an increase of 37% on last year
- Currency futures rise 311% year-on-year to reach 82,750 contracts in July
- Year-to-date volumes crossed the One Million mark in July and stood at 1,090,645 contracts as at end of July, an increase of 46% on last year

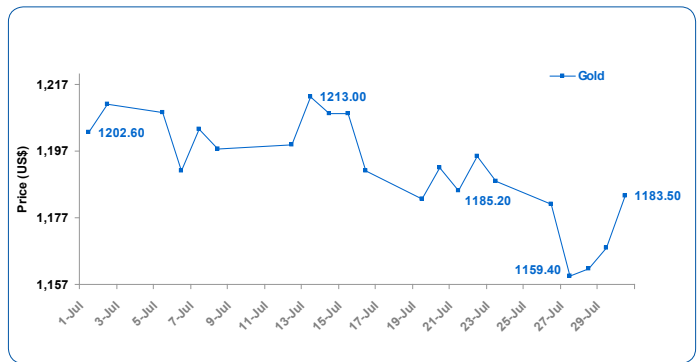

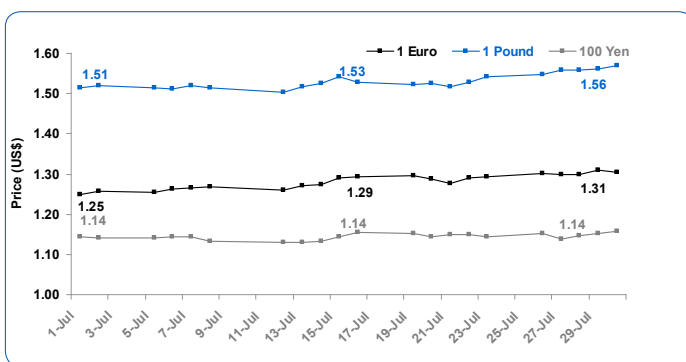
Energy Futures Settlement Prices



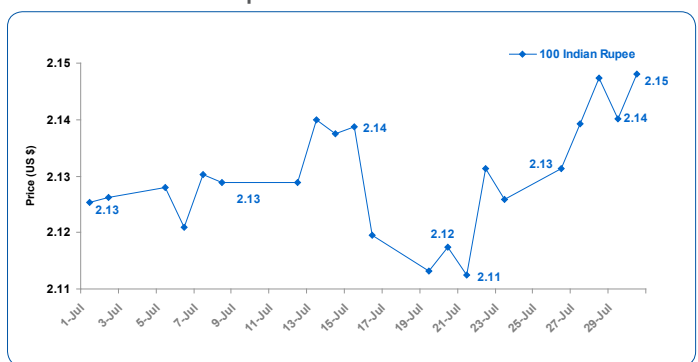
Gold Futures Settlement Prices



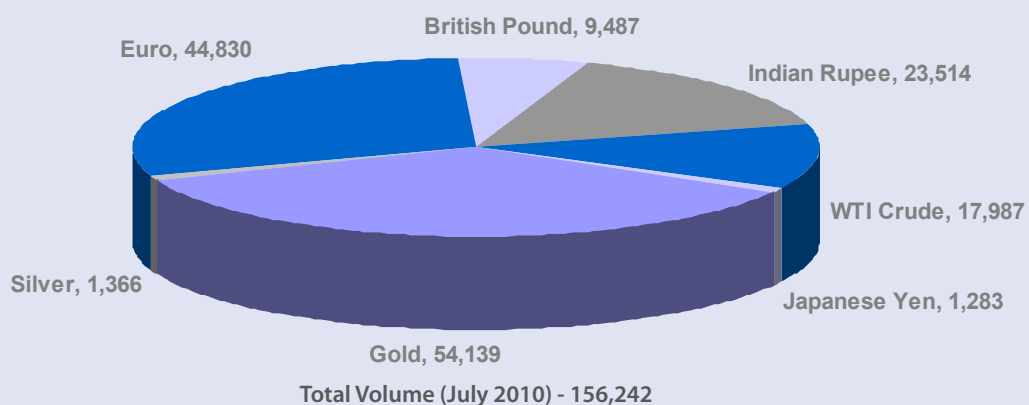
Euro, Pound, Yen Futures Settlement Prices
