## Sub: Change in password policy

In pursuance of By-Laws of DGCX and Clearing Rules of DCCC and Notice # TECH-2007-018 dated May 23, 2007, it is hereby notified as under:

Please note that based on the request received from our members, Exchange has decided to redefine the forced password change policy option from 14 days to 90 days. This policy will be applicable for the Member Administrator Terminal (MAT), Trader Workstation Terminal (TWS), FIX Clients and SSL VPN login.

Members can however change the passwords at any given point of time for their respective terminals, prior to the expiry period of 90 days. Please be noted that last three passwords can not be repeated (instead of last six as per the present policy) for TWS, MAT & FIX Client application. As a good practice it is recommended that member should change the password frequently.

<u>Password construction</u>: There is no change on the existing policy, i.e. the password should be of minimum of 6 characters length and must contains at least one alphabet, one special character and one digit. Please refer our Notice No. TECH-2007-011 dated April 16, 2007 and TECH-2006-003 dated March 3, 2006 for details. For SSL VPN login the password length should be minimum of 8 characters length and should contain at least one alphabet and one digit.

The new password policy will be enforced from May 28, 2007.

Members are requested to take a note of the same and kindly contact our Helpdesk in case of any further clarifications.
